PUBLIC NOTICE

To all persons qualified to vote and who are entitled to be entered on the referendum list of the Municipality of the Township of Gore

PUBLIC NOTICE is given as follows:

THAT following the public consultation meeting held February 11, 2019 concerning drafts of the urbanism By-laws, the municipal council adopted the following By-laws at a special meeting held on February 18, 2019 ;

1. Zoning By-law number 214;
2. Subdivision By-law number 216.

THAT the Zoning By-law number 214 and Subdivision By-law number 216 will replace the existing Zoning By-law number 152 and the Subdivision By-law number 153 respectively.

THAT the time period during which any person from the municipality that is qualified to vote on these By-laws could ask the *Commission Municipale du Québec* for its opinion regarding the conformity of Zoning By-law number 214 and Subdivision By-law number 216 with regards to the Planning Program By-law 213, has expired.

THAT the Zoning By-law number 214 and the Subdivision By-law number 216 must be submitted to qualified voters for approval, as prescribed by the procedures regarding the five-year statutory review detailed in the Act respecting land use planning and development (L.R.Q., c.A-19.1).

THAT qualified voters who are entitled to be registered on the referendum list of the Municipality of the Township of Gore may request that the above mentioned By-laws be subject to a referendum poll in accordance with the registration procedures provided for in sections 514 to 579 of the Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities (R.L.R.Q., c. E-2.2). This is done by entering their name, address, voting capacity and signature in the registers opened for this purpose.

THAT the registers will be available from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. on May 2, 2019, at the municipal office located at 9, Cambria Road.

THAT the number of registrations required for a referendum poll to be held for the Zoning By-law number 214 or the Subdivision By-law number 216 is 427 per By-law.

THAT a qualified voter is:

- a. Any person who, on February 18, 2019, is not disqualified from voting as per section 524 of the Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities (R.L.R.Q., c. E-2.2) and who meets the following conditions:
 - Be a natural person domiciled in the Municipality of the Township of Gore and has been domiciled in Québec for at least 6 months;
 - Be of legal age and a Canadian citizen who is not under curatorship.
- b. Any owner of an immovable or occupant of a business establishment who meets the following conditions on February 18, 2019:
 - Be the owner of an immovable or the sole occupant of a business establishment located within the municipality of the Township of Gore for at least 12 months;
 - In the case of a natural person, be of legal age, have Canadian citizenship and not be under curatorship or unable to vote.
- c. In the case of undivided co-owners of a building or co-occupants of a business establishment:
 - Be designated, by power of attorney signed by the majority of co-owners or co-occupants who are concerned parties, as the person entitled to sign the register on their behalf;
 - The designated person must not be inscribed, or be entitled to be inscribed, on the referendum list in a capacity having greater priority.
- d. In the case of a legal person:
 - Be a natural person, designated from its members, directors or employees by way of a resolution, to represent the legal person and on February 18, 2019, be of legal age, a Canadian citizen, not be under curatorship or unable to vote;
 - Except in the case of a person designated as the representative of a legal person, no one may be considered a concerned party or be registered on the referendum list in more than one capacity.

THAT the result of the registration process will be announced at 7 p.m. or as soon as it is available, on May 2, 2019, at the municipal office of the Municipality of the Township of Gore, located at 9, Cambria Road.

THAT if 427 entries are not inscribed in a register of one of the By-laws, the said By-law will be considered approved by the qualified voters.

THAT when and if the Zoning By-law number 214 and Subdivision By-law number 216 are deemed approved by qualified voters, the legal procedure regarding the five-year statutory review process described in the Act respecting land use planning and development (L.R.Q., c.A-19.1) will proceed until the By-laws come into effect;

THAT the Zoning By-law number 214 and the Subdivision By-law number 216, as well as the plans and maps that form an integral part thereof, are available for consultation at the municipal office of the Municipality of the Township of Gore, located at 9, Cambria Road during normal business hours.
