#### MUNICIPAL INFORMATION

#### **LAKE BARRON BOAT LAUNCH -2025 PROCEDURE**

To access Lake Barron, you must complete the Application Form, available on our website, in the environment section. You can also complete it at the municipal office. The 2025 access rights are as follows:

Access fees are payable in person at the municipal office, by mail, or online with your banking institution. All boats must be washed before being launched.

WHAT'S NEW IN 2025: There is now an attendant at the Barron Lake boat launch, who will be present from Friday, May 16, 2025, to Monday, September 1, according to the following schedule:

FRIDAYS: 3 PM - 7 PM

SATURDAYS AND SUNDAYS: 8 AM - 4 PM

If you wish to access the boat launch at other times during the week, you can make an appointment with someone at Town Hall, Monday to Thursday, from 9 AM to 5 PM. The cost of launching by appointment is \$20 (plus the sticker fee).

The attendant is responsible for ensuring the cleanliness of the boats. THE ATTENDANT WILL NOT ISSUE STICKERS, which must be done at Town Hall during the week. NO BOATS WITHOUT A STICKER WILL BE ALLOWED AT THE BOAT LAUNCH.

These additional control measures were implemented in collaboration with the Lake Barron Association to preserve the lake and increase control of aquatic invasive species.

#### **BOAT WASHING STATION**

For two years now, there has been a new self-service boat washing station available at the municipal park (45 Cambria Road). Washing boats before launching them on any body of water is an effective measure to prevent the proliferation of invasive aquatic species on the Township's waterways. For users of Lake Barron, washing boats is mandatory to obtain access to the lake. The cleanliness of the boats will be carefully checked by the boat launch attendant.



#### **NEWS FROM THE ALLIANCE OF ASSOCIATIONS OF THE LAKES OF GORE**

Over the past few years, the Alliance has brought together more than twenty lakes that have established or intend to establish a lake association. The Alliance is a spontaneous grouping of volunteers. Gore Township is home to 36 named lakes and over a hundred wetlands. Monitoring them to keep them as healthy as possible is essential.

Your lake associations conduct annual inventories of aquatic plants, monitor for invasive species, ensure to the best of their ability that boats are washed, and much more. In doing so, these associations and groups reinforce the spirit of community: it's important to support them.

The Alliance facilitates the sharing and communication of these activities, experiences, news and concerted actions between the associations and the municipality. The list of associations is available on the municipal website (Municipal Services - Environment). The municipality of Gore carries out various environmental actions that are shared with the Alliance and the general public. It takes samples and performs analyses every year to detect potential problems and monitor changes over time. It also monitors the shorelines and provides annual reports (available on the web). The importance of maintaining the health of our lakes and their shores is paramount to maintaining the ecosystem and the value of your properties.

The Alliance will be present May 24<sup>th</sup> for the great Environment Day at the Municipal Park, come visit us from 10 am!




